**FLU VACCINATION POLICY:** all horses attending the event must have either completed a primary course of injections (initial two) within 7months, or had a routine booster within 12months prior to the event. Passports will be checked and may be presented at either course walking on Saturday or on the day on collection of numbers. You may also submit photos of the front page plus vaccination page of the passport via email.

#### **Class 1: 70CM "HAVE A GO" – 9-9:45am (riders will not be allowed to start after 9:45am)**

*Open to all ages and combinations. Competitors may go around solo or in pairs and may go around more than once subject to time and/or space*

£10 per competitor per round Rosettes to all clear rounds

#### **Class 2: 80CM PAIRS – 10am start**

*Open to all ages and combinations*

£25 per pair JJ Equestrian Challenge Trophies will be awarded to the winning pair. Rosettes to 10<sup>th</sup> place

#### **Class 3: 80CM JUNIOR NOVICE – approx. 11:15am start**

*Combinations not to have won more than three Novice Hunter Trials at this height or above*

£15 per competitor A Silver Horse Trophy will be awarded to the winner. Rosettes to 6<sup>th</sup> place  
The CHSC Challenge Shield will be awarded to the highest placed CHPC member

#### **Class 4: 80CM SENIOR NOVICE – approx. 12:30pm start**

*Combinations not to have won more than three Novice Hunter Trials at this height or above*

£15 per competitor The Twilight Equine Shield will be awarded to the winner. Rosettes to 10<sup>th</sup> Place  
The Harbins Challenge Cup will be awarded to the highest placed CH with EC Sub'

#### **Class 5: 90CM OPEN PAIRS - approx. 2:30pm start**

*Open to all ages and combinations*

£25 per pair Rosettes to 6<sup>th</sup> place

#### **Class 6: 90CM OPEN - approx. 3:15pm start**

*Juniors and seniors will run together, open to all ages and combinations*

£15 per competitor Highest placed junior – The D K Pearce Challenge Scroll  
Highest placed senior – The Gilbert Rice Van & Truck Centre Challenge Trophy. Rosettes to 10<sup>th</sup> place

**RULES AND REGULATIONS OF ENTRY:**

1. The Organisers shall not be liable for any claim in respect of damage or accident to any competitor, spectator, servant, horse or vehicle howsoever caused in connection with the event or arising there from. All competitors participate in the event at their own risk.
2. Competitors will be responsible for the control of their animals at all times and will be liable for any veterinary/farriery expenses incurred on the day.
3. Competitors that fall anywhere on the course/show ground may continue but do so at their own risk. Eliminated competitors may continue but must give way to other riders.
4. Competitors must wear correct riding attire including, but not limited to, protective head covering to the current safety standards at all times when mounted. Body protectors are compulsory.
5. No rider may carry or use a whip exceeding 30inches in length. Excessive use of whip and/or bad language will not be tolerated, and the competitor will be asked to leave the show ground.
6. Competitors with long hair must secure it properly so as not to obscure their bib number.
7. Outside assistance is forbidden in all classes. Including, but not limited to, the use of personal timing equipment.
8. All riders must give way to competitors travelling at a faster pace.
- 9. Competitors please note: there is no drinking water for horses on the show ground.**
10. The organisers reserve the right to abandon any class.
11. Objections must be made to the Event Secretary within 30minutes of the incident taking place, accompanied by a deposit of £10, which may be forfeited if the objection is overruled. The decision of the Event Secretary is final in all respects.
12. All dogs to be on short leads at all times. Dogs will be welcome at course walking but will not be allowed on the course on the day of the event. All mess picked up and disposed of appropriately.
13. Entry fees are non-refundable, except where a valid/current Vet's Certificate or Doctor's note is produced.
14. Entries in all classes will be strictly limited. Entries after the closing date will only be accepted where space allows.
15. All trophies awarded and signed for must be returned on request prior to the following year's event. [a minimum of one month's notice will be given]
16. All horses attending the event will be up to date with flu vaccinations and passports presented as detailed in the schedule. Failure to comply will result in forfeit of all entry fees and being asked to leave the Showground immediately.
