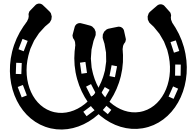

Covid-19 safety...

Due to COVID-19 restrictions entries will be limited – entries close Saturday 5th September. no entries will be accepted on the day

Once entries and payment have been received you will be issued with a start time. Groups will be limited to 6 riders. If you wish to enter as a group you must enter as a group with 1 person managing the booking on behalf of the group. The lead contact will be responsible for informing the group of their start time. Riders must be ready to start at their allocated time.

Stewards will be in the parking area to ensure socially distanced parking. There will be no toilets on site, rosettes or refreshments. All riders will be responsible for their own hygiene arrangements and leave the site promptly on completion of the ride.

St John's Ambulance will be in attendance. Stewards will be present on the cross country course. All riders must have read and accept to the below terms and conditions.

Terms and conditions...

Riders will be responsible for the control of their animals and liable to any veterinary/farriery expenses incurred during the day.

All riders must have access to a mobile phone in order to summon assistance in the event of an emergency.

Hats MUST be worn and correctly fastened at all times when handling horses and when mounted to the current British Equestrian Trade Association (BETA) standard. Body protectors to meet the current BETA Standard must also be worn when mounted as well as suitable riding footwear.

Any damage to fences should be reported to the organisers.

It is compulsory to give way to members of the public using the public footpaths or riders using public bridleways that cross the route. We ask you exercise the general courtesy, as you would expect upon yourself, when meeting other riders

Visiting dogs are permitted but must be kept on leads and under control at all times.

Riders using the cross country course must not jump any jump marked with 'crossed flags' as this indicates that the jump must not be used under any circumstances.

Headcams are worn at riders own risk

The organisers reserve the right to abandon in adverse weather conditions

Please note there is no water on site – please bring your own

Rubbish must be taken home – please do not leave for others to pick up.
